As we progress, the committee will oversee the review of candidates and conduct the interviews. We invite and encourage all members to participate in this important journey by relating our pastoral search to friends and family throughout your own unique networks, referring any potential candidates to the committee. Your prayers, support, and engagement are vital as we seek God's guidance for our congregation's future.

During this interim period, regular worship services have been led by supply pastors, who have been inspiring to those who have attended worship. Regular attendance and tithes and gifts to the church are especially important during this period. Let us trust in God's faithfulness and wisdom as we move forward together. May the Holy Spirit guide our hearts and minds in unity and love during this search.



President Michael Simons called meeting to order and opened with a prayer.

Devotions were given by Sheila Harrington.

Minutes were reviewed and Sheila made a motion to approve minutes. Kelsey seconded this motion. Motion carried.

Opening comments by President Michael Simons.

Michael reported that we had positive results from the Temple Talk given regarding church funds. The fact that final revenues fell short again this year further supports the decision to trim the 2026 budget. WHAT IS LENT

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.



REMINDER: BLAST/Confirmation time during lent is 6:15pm—6:55pm. Confirmation students are expected to attend worship at 7:00pm.

Soup Supper/Lenten Services will start on Ash Wednesday, February 18th, and continue through March 25th. Soup Supper is from 5:30pm—6:45pm with Worship Service starting at 7:00pm. Sign up sheets are at the back of the church for anyone willing to bring food for the suppers or work.
