A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in Christ!

The month of May. This is my favorite month. Everything is green and you can see forever. The air is warm and soothing, the sky is blue, the birds are singing. God's grace is rampant and plentiful. It is easy for all to see!

The deck on the back of the Parsonage gets a lot of use from both Lorna and I at this point. We spend a lot of time out there, eat most of our meals there, play games and just enjoy God's creation...worshipping God's Son while we sit in the sun.

Many of you are aware of the fact Lorna has been diagnosed with bladder cancer. This cancer is not curable. It is treatable. She will be starting a regimen of Chemotherapy and Immunotherapy very soon. (By the time you read this, she will have received multiple cycles of treatment). She will be receiving this treatment for the rest of her life. Eventually, cancer will win, but the treatment is the gold standard for this form of cancer, and we have every reason to expect her to live for quite a while.

Obviously, we have spent a lot of time praying about this, asking God to heal her, to take away this horrible disease. If God wishes this to happen, it will.

If God says it is better for her to not be healed, then she won't be.

Lorna had another form of cancer 28 years ago. She had surgery and then radiation to cure her at that time. The Doctor's tell us this cancer is caused by the radiation she received to cure the old cancer.

I am struck by the fact Jesus cured many people in Scripture. Other people performed healings in Scripture. I have seen people in my lifetime who have been cured of various diseases, including cancer, miraculously by the laying on of hands. Something I have never seen is a 2,000-year-old person walking around the world. None of the people that Jesus cured is still alive physically, today.

I can choose to be angry that God has allowed this horrible disease back into Lorna's life and be angry that it will cut short our time together, or I can be thankful that God has given us an additional 28 years together, to live, to laugh, to love. I choose to be grateful.
